Group Descriptions



0-4 Year Old Play & Learn Group

free-play and group activities for children in the specified age range

will be offered. Playgroup includes a provided snack and circle time. Families are encouraged to sign up for a rotating weekly reading backpack. The backpack includes at least 3 books and a short tip sheet on reading to children.



Hull's Music Makers: This is a weekly themed music class. You and your child will explore rhythm and movement while singing, playing instruments and having a good time. This group is for

children of all ages and is adjusted based on the participants' ages.



We offer the Ages & Stages Screening Questionnaire (ASQ) three times a year. We hand out the developmental screener in the fall and spring and offer the social-emotional screener during the winter session. This year, as part of the Statewide Week of the Young

Child, April 8-12th, we will be offering the developmental screening to all group attendees. If you would like to complete the screener online you may go to https://www.asqonline.com/landing_pages. After you complete the screener, Joan will score it and provide an individualized developmental tip sheet. These tip sheets provide a variety of fun activities you can do with your child to support their development.
